




- A set of actions taken to prevent or mitigate potential disaster impacts before a shock or before acute impacts are felt
- Faster, cheaper and more dignified than traditional humanitarian response
- Reduces losses and suffering before they occur

### **Components of anticipatory action**




#### **OpenStreetMap**

working with partners to ensure map data is accessible and used in decisions that save and improve lives,






### Local people & local tools: add knowledge

**Tools** 


locally made or already owned, low tech apps

## **Remote mapping:** from anywhere using a browser, drawing buildings and roads






#### Identifying unmapped and high-risk areas in Sudan


