About ICVA

Founded in 1962, ICVA (International Council of Voluntary Agencies) is a global network of over 130 nongovernmental organisations (NGOs) active in 160 countries, operating at global, regional, national and local levels, whose mission is to make humanitarian action more principled and effective by working collectively and independently to influence policy and practice. ICVA promotes and facilitates effective NGO engagement in the humanitarian sector, with a focus on Forced Migration, Humanitarian Coordination, Humanitarian Financing, and cross-cutting systems-strengthening issues.

Background to the Consultancy

ICVA has regional Representatives based in Nairobi and Senegal who require support for their day-to-day functions until a recruitment is finalised. This is therefore a short- term gap fill and has the opportunity for the consultant to apply for a longer-term role with ICVA.

The consultant will be providing additional support to both representatives and will be expected to fill a capacity gap in support of their daily work.

The consultant will be expected to

- Support with existing projects as well as assist with design and drafting of new grant proposals as needed
- Support with donor reporting for certain projects
- Follow weekly meetings of the Working Group and execute follow up action points
- Develop weekly recaps of regional outcomes for ICVA weekly email
- Provide coordination support in a number of areas as directed
- Support a regional workshop
- Support with administrative functions for the representatives such as drafting of documents and reports

The consultant requirements:

- Experience in Grant/ project management
- Experience in humanitarian field, ideally in senior role
- Experience in coordination
- Excellent communication skills
- Fluency in both English and French

Reporting Lines

The consultant will work in close collaboration with ICVA Africa Regional Representatives, one in Nairobi and one in Dakar. The portfolio of work will likely be split 50/50 between West and Central Africa and East and Southern Africa.
